In order to take full advantage of these Town Meeting sessions, **individuals should bring the following items with them to the meeting: proof of income, list of prescription drugs, Social Security card, name of pharmacy that they use, and their present insurance carrier information.** All of this information will help counselors be able to assist individuals in determining eligibility for various programs and to help determine what type of plan may benefit the consumer the most.
