He will be on hand from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. to offer free appraisals and even help answer the occasional question, “What is it?” There are no charges and no reservations necessary for the “Antiques Sideshow”.

Seniors are invited to bring the one or two items that they would like to learn more about, but need to limit the size to nothing larger than can be carried in two hands. If you don’t have an item, just bring your curiosity because the event is sure to be intriguing.

The Clearfield Senior Community Center is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3 p.m. Activities are offered daily and a congregate meal is available at noon for county residents aged 60 and older on a donation basis.
